

The September shoot hopefully marked the end of the heat. Now we can get down to some serious shooting and also to getting some work done on our range. People have been busy working behind the scenes off and on this summer but now it it time to lay out some projects and set some priorities. Here is a list of the projects that need to be done before the rains come in November.

- 1. The roof on the registration office must be made leak proof. Miss Anne Laughitoff and Mad Dog Draper are working with her brother to make sure we get it right this time. Cost: unknown at this time.
- 2. The roof on our outhouse must follow the same suit. It would also be great if we could complete the inside of the men's roof/skylight like it is on the ladies. Special thanks to Miss Foxie Schoolmarm and Miss Barah Lee Missdit for sprucing up the ladies comfort station.
- **3**. The town council decided to save the Assay Office. Grandpa has priced out putting in a new sub-floor and we hope to pursue that in late September. Cost: about \$225. Once the floor is complete we will also need to cover the roof with corrugated metal. We will need a crew of 4-5 guys to give up a Sat. or Sunday. It will probably take the better part of a day to complete. Lunch will again be provided by Rat River Catering.
- **4.** Grandpa says the loading tables need another coat of waterproofing, but first they will have to be cleaned of dirt, bird residue etc. If you would like to volunteer for this project it will take about 3-4 hours. Club will supply all materials and paint brushes. Please let the mayor know as Grandpa is currently on vacation. Not limited to men (hint, hint).
- **5**. All bay facades, walkways, etc. must be shored up, nailed down and in general made safe to use. Would all bay caretakers please go over the condition of your facade and any props attached thereto and let the mayor know what needs to be done if you cannot take care of it yourself. Also, in preparation for She-Bang please make sure your bay is weed and wad free. Most of them just need a little touching up. Thanks.
