The December match was put on by Mad Trapper of Rat River. I personally love giving Trapper a bad time, but truth be told it was a fun and creative match (boy that hurt).

The January match is being staged by Utah Blaine and Lap Dog. This will be a three day match, Saturday, Sunday and Monday. There will be a Rifle, Handgun and Shotgun challenge sprinkled throughout the three days. The Bones Brannon Designed .22 arcades will be up and running for the entire weekend. Somewhere during the three days I will put together a "semi long range event" for single shot and lever action rifles.

Mescalero will be doing the side matches. Any and all the help we can get to keep things running would be appreciated. Bring plenty of ammo because you will be able to shoot both categories (pocket pistol and derringer) and go through the stage as many times as you like. See the SASS handbook for the definition of pocket pistols if you aren't sure what is included. We will have a .22 derringer to loan for anybody who wants to shoot this side match but doesn't own a pocket pistol or derringer. If you've never tried to shoot quickly and accurately with a derringer, it is an enlightening experience. And you have the opportunity to win VALUABLE prizes !!!

Sunday afternoon we will have a team shoot. Three-person teams will be formed by drawing names out of a hat. One person will shoot primarily their pistols, another primarily their rifle, and the third primarily their shotgun. The stage will be written to ensure plenty of action for the shooters and plenty of entertainment for the spectators. Again, bring plenty of ammo, because you will have the opportunity to shoot the stage more than once.

Bring in the New Year at 5 Dogs Creek FINAL REMINDER !!!

The 5 Dogs Creek gang will have a three-day match to bring in the New Year! Join us for Friday and Saturday, December 30-31, and Sunday and Monday, January 1-2. There will be a 15 main match stages: five on Saturday, five on Sunday, and five on Monday. Each day is a separate match but there will also be awards for the composite three day total.

Utah Blaine and Lap Dog are planning the main match stages, which will include one challenge stage on each of the three days: one-day pistol, one-day rifle, and one-day shotgun.

Mescalero is planning the side-matches. Saturday, December 31, there will be a pocket pistol/derringer side-match, and a long range lever and single shot rifle side-match. If you do not have a derringer one will be available so no excuses. On Sunday, January 1, there will be team shoot.

In addition to the shooting, there will be potluck dinners on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Friday hot dogs will be provided, on Saturday the club will provide barbecued turkeys; and for Sunday it's "stone soup."

Bring your favorite side-dishes for the Friday and Saturday potlucks; bring your favorite vegetable or meat to add to the stone soup, and any side dish you may wish to contribute.

Following the Sunday evening potluck dinner, a movie will be shown which will reveal from whence come the lines for each of the main match stages. If you would like to join us on Friday our .22 arcade will be set up for you shooting pleasure, so bring your .22 pistols and rifles. If you don't have .22 ammo, we may be able to rustle up a handful one place or another. The .22 arcade will also be available Saturday and Sunday. We will also have a BB gun stage set up on Friday, so bring along you BB gun as well. Whew, that's a lot of shootin' folks.
