Friday night hot dog roast and Saturday night pot luck! A TEAM SHOOT is planned for Saturday after the day's match scores are read.

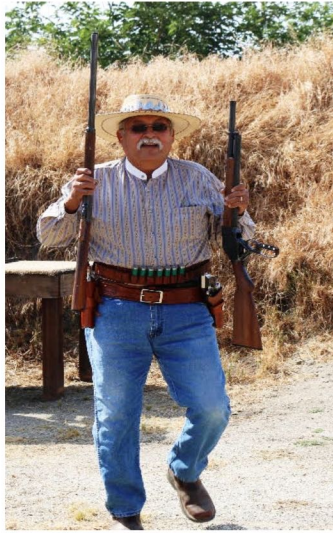
