LABOR DAY SHOOT AT 5 DOGS CREEK

5 Dogs Creek will once again have a Labor Day Shoot. You are welcome to bring your RV any time Friday, September 1st and stay through until Tuesday, September 5th. There is no charge for camping on the range. There is water available, though the number of outlets is not extensive; however, if you have plenty of hose, we can arrange for multiple users from each outlet. And you can fill your RV water tank at the range. If you would like to do any shooting on Friday, there will be a \$10 fee. Our club does not profit from this fee, it goes directly to the owner of the 5 Dogs Range. Our .22 Arcade will be available Friday afternoon for your shooting pleasure. It will also be available Saturday and Sunday afternoons. We will also make one stage available Friday afternoon for those of you that may want to do a little practicing with your cowboy/cowgirl guns. We will have a five-stage main match on Saturday and another five-stage main match on Sunday. There will be a three stage Wild Bunch match on Saturday afternoon. Saturday evening is "game night, cards, dominos, or any game you can recruit enough folks to play. There will be a team shoot Sunday afternoon, and a movie Sunday night, where the stage lines for the main match will be revealed.

Monday will be devoted to side matches: long range single shoot (black powder or smokeless), long range lever rifle (pistol or rifle caliber), and speed pistol, rifle, and shotgun. To expedite the speed matches the first participant will shoot through pistol, rifle, and shotgun, followed by the next participant, and so on. Each participant will have two opportunities to shoot through however many speed matches they elect to engage. The 5 Dogs Creek club will provide hamburgers for dinner on Friday evening. You are on your own for lunch. There will be a potluck dinner both Saturday and Sunday evening. You may put as much or as little "labor" into whatever main, side, or dessert you want to bring for the potluck.

There will be a "special" award for each shooting event. And there will be a "raffle" of sorts, with "valuable" prizes; there is no cost for raffle participation.
