Howdy 5 Dogs Members,

It is with great pleasure that I send news from the IRS, odd as that may seem!

It was determined by the IRS that we qualify for exemption from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501 (c) (7) – a **social club**. We will need to file **IRS Form 990 (an informational tax return)** each year to maintain our exempt status. **We do not have to pay any income tax on income we receive, but money paid to the club is not tax deductible (we are not a charity).**

There was no mention of any fees or penalties owed by our club at this time. That could change but I'm going to stay positive that it will not.

Our next course of action is to file with the State for exemption. I mailed the request forms on Monday 9-17-18. I have been told that once the Federal government has given exemption, the State will follow suit. We will see.

So far, so good!!
