Howdy All

The October match was put on by Buddy Love, it was a fun match, with a handgun reload and also shooting the Texas Star with your handgun. Thankfully Sister Sangria disavowed any responsibility for the match or we would be adding a name to the wall of shame. I think everyone had a good time both days. Thank you, Buddy Love, for all your hard work, also Sister Sangria for helping him set it up.

The November match is She Bang, put on by the lovely ladies of 5 Dogs Creek, if you bring an unwrapped present for Toys for Tots valued at \$10 00 or more the shooting fee for that day will be reduced to \$10.00. We will be doing this on both days, one gift each day to get the reduced shooting fee for that day. We will also be selling Dog Nabbits 5 for \$10.00, you can use them to erase a miss they will not erase a procedural or a safety, any unused Dog Nabbits you can put in the jar for the drawing after the match. If you make out a check for the Dog Nabbits to Toys for Tots your donation would be tax deductible.

No one other than shooters and Persons working with the posse are allowed on the stage past the split rail fence. Eye and ear protection are mandatory. All visitors and onlookers on the range between the split rail fence and the drive way eye protection is mandatory and ear protection is recommended. Everyone on the range while we are shooting must sign the release form at the club office, if there are minor children their guardian must fill out the form and sign the release for them. It is the responsibility of all club members to enforce these rules for everyone's safety, be polite but firm. There is eye and ear protection in the office for club members to loan out to any visitor that may need it.

Active members with a valid membership card can use the cowboy range on the days the main range is open. You will need to go to the main range office and sign their release form and pay their daily shooting fee and show your valid membership card. You must have your valid membership card or you will be turned away and not allowed to use the cowboy range. If this happens, this will be your fault not Dave Olds or any of his range employees, please treat them with the utmost respect. If you find someone or group of people shooting on our range that you don't recognize ask to see their membership card and don't feel insulted if you are asked to show yours. Let's all protect our range the props and the targets. Any time you're on the cowboy range all SASS ammunition rules apply.
