Fellow 5 Dogs Creek Members,

Congratulations! You are going to write the stages for a shooting weekend. Setting up for the match is just as easy. Once you have your stages approved by the Sheriff you need to decide when to set up the stages. You can do this anytime the range is open, including after the Sunday match. You will need to attach signs that say "Do not move the targets; they are set for thematch" on the facade easily visible. You fill in the month of the match. Painting can be done anytime, including the Friday of the match. Ask for help setting up and painting, cowboys and cowgirls are always willing to help.

On the Saturday of the match you need to be out to the range a little early to put the rugs on the tables as well as the tray for spent brass, put out the orange trash buckets, and the gray trash cans at the unloading table. You will find everything in the 'El Burrito' (except for the gray trash cans which are on the bays) which is located in the red barn, which you take out and pull to the stages. At the end of the day, you pick up everything, empty the trash cans and put the gray cans either on the boardwalk or behind the facade. If it is Saturday put 'El Burrito' under the cover by the picnic tables so you are ready to go on Sunday. On Sunday, 'El Burrito' goes back into the red barn after everything is picked up.

It is that easy and again, cowboys and cowgirls are always willing to help. And I am always happy to help or answer questions.

Proposed rule change: Eliminate the automatic Stage DQ penalty for leaving the loading table with a cocked rifle. In such instances, the shooter will be directed to point the rifle safely into the back berm, bring the hammer to full cock if it is in the half-cock/safety position, then pull the trigger. If no round is fired, the shooter will be directed to finish staging firearms in order to start the stage (No Call). If a round fires when the shooter pulls the trigger, the shooter will be assessed a Stage DQ and directed to proceed to the unloading table. This Rule change will take effect January 1, 2020.
