The Town Council of 5 Dogs Creek were trying to put together social distancing rules to try to have a match for the month of June. After talking with the council members and the position of the State of California it is looking like we will be looking more towards July.

5 Dogs Range will be reopening for business on the Memorial Day weekend. Their new hours will be from 8AM to 6PM, their gates will not be open until 8AM, no shots may be fired before and after these hours. Their days of operation will remain the same: Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

5 Dogs Creek Cowboy Shooting range can also be used by our members starting on the same dates listed above, we do ask you to limit the number of people to 2 to 4 people per bay while practicing social distancing. All standard fees must be paid as usual at the main range office on the hill.

The weekend of June 5th and 6th some of the town council will be camping at the range to practice, visit and go over what safety precautions we will need to put in place to reopen the range for a monthly match. We will be practicing social distancing but anyone that would like to come for the weekend or just the day to visit or practice shooting are welcome. 5 Dogs Creek will not be supplying water so bring your own. Remember to go to the main office at 5 Dogs Range and sign their release and pay their fees if you're going to shoot.
