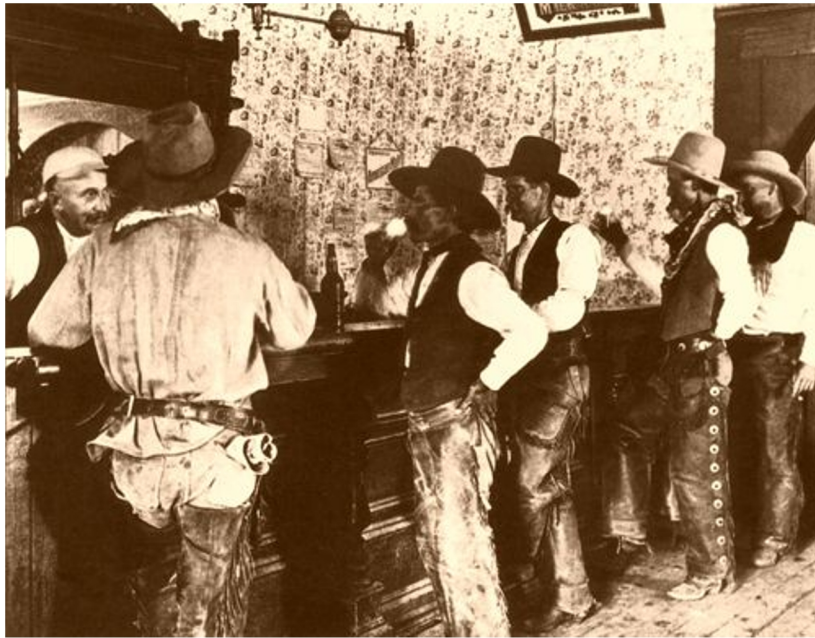

Please read through the current rules in place for 5 Dogs Creek matches.

### **5 DOGS CREEK MATCH ACTION PROPOSAL**

1. Exact cash or check required. No change will be given.
2. COVID 19 Social Distancing guidelines will be adhered to.
3. 5 Dogs Creek (5 DC) will request that ANYONE FEELING ILL, has a new cough or running a temperature to PLEASE STAY HOME.
4. 5 DC will implement a waiver that implies that individuals are knowingly risking exposure to COVID 19 by participating or spectating at club matches.
5. Hand sanitizer will be available at the registration office.
6. Poses will be limited in size. Due to social distancing guidelines, last persons registering may be moved to a different posse, as necessary, to maintain an acceptable posse size.
7. Social Distancing will be expected to be observed by all those attending matches at 5 Dogs Creek. The only exception will be those living in the same household, which may be within 6 feet of one another. The Timer Operator will have to step close for a short time, to start the shooter, then ideally step back, unless the shooter can hear the buzzer to start.

## 5 DOGS CREEK MATCH ACTION PROPOSAL (cont'd)

8. There will be only two scorekeepers. No others will touch the tablets or a posse score sheet. The individual score sheets will not be used by scorekeepers. If you would like to keep your score sheet, you will need to keep your individual score.

9. Shooters will be asked to provide their own pens and pencils to register and to keep their own score sheet.

10. Hand soap will be provided at the hand washing station.

11. Hand sanitizer or wipes will be provided with each posse.

12. Face masks or bandanas will be required by all attendees.

13. Shooters that live together may use the same gun cart, guns, ammo and so on. Others do so at their own risk.

14. Bring your own water 5 Dogs Creek will not be supplying water.

15. There will not be a pot luck dinner until COVID 19 is over.

16. We will only read scores if people space themselves out at the tables.

17. No fireworks will be allowed at the range.
