### The Mayor's Anvil: Forging Understanding By Mayor Fordyce Beals

Remington's first percussion revolver:
The 1st Model Beals

Fordyce Beals returned to the Remington company in 1856 to create their first percussion revolver. The First Model Beals revolver was based on two patents: No. 15,167 of 26 June 1856, patenting the cylinder rotating method, and No. 17,359 of 24 May 1857 patenting the cylinder locking system. Both patent dates are visible on the top of the barrel. In 1858 Beals redesigned the frame to accept a sheath trigger without the need for a trigger guard. This resulted in the Second Model Beals revolver. The last addition to the pocket revolver family came in September 1858 based on patent No. 21,478 that added the Beals-style loading ramrod, that had to be lowered to be able to pull the axis of the cylinder.








F. BEALS. Revolver.






1900 - Stage Line Map County Atlas Kern County, California
