FRIDAY, JULY 4TH MORNING MATCH—Mandatory shooter's meeting at 7:30 AM, match begins at 8:00 AM. Cost will be \$7.00 for members and \$10.00 for non-members.

<u>SATURDAY</u>, <u>JULY 5TH</u> MORNING MATCH—Mandatory shooter's meeting at 7:30 AM, match begins at 8:00 AM. Cost is \$7.00 for members and \$10.00 for non-members.

<u>SUNDAY</u>, <u>JULY 6TH</u>—REGULAR MONTHLY MATCH—Mandatory shooter's meeting at 8:30 AM, match begins at 9:00 am. Cost is \$12.00 for members and \$17.00 for non-members.

Almost Dangerous will be cooking dinner on Friday and Saturday evenings. Cost is \$8.00 per meal.
