November battle at 5 Dogs Creek: Blue vs. Gray

From Fort Sumter to the "final battle" at the Mason-Dixon Line, the November match was a great shoot and a Civil War history lesson. Smiley, Hartford and Memphis Slim put their best foot forward when organizing this 5 stage match.

When signing in for the day, shooters had to declare their allegiance to the North (blue) or South (gray). The targets shot during the stages often depended on the side you had selected with Northerners shooting at gray targets and Southerners shooting at blue targets.

Many shooters got into the spirit of the day wearing uniforms and shooting black powder. Each stage included a brief historical narrative for Civil War battles, including Battle of Blackburn's

Ford, Battle of Bull Run, Second Battle of Manassas and Battle of Sharpsburg.

A team shoot was organized as sixth stage with a true North vs. South show down. The "army" cutting a post in half first would win the final battle. The North defended their title and again won the war!
